

More August and September Checklist

- Remove flammable BBQ covers and clean out grease pans
- Keep a fire extinguisher near outdoor BBQ.
- Continue to keep hoses connected throughout the dry season
- Fill a water tight large outdoor garbage can with water. Keep a bucket close by. In case of fires fill bucket to put out small ember spot fire.
- A car's floor mat can be used to put out small ember spot fires.
- Redwood trees are beginning to drop their needles - Keep roofs and gutters cleared of debris
- Scan or copy important documents, photographs, and save to memory stick
- Make a list of valuable you want to take and keep it with your Go-Gab Having a list will help speed evacuation.
- Keep a plastic bag of medicines in an easily accessible location.
- Keep a sturdy pair of shoes by bedside

Have you:

- **Packed a Go-Bag** for each member of your family and your pet?
- **Established designated a shelter**, or friend/family member's home to evacuate to?
- **Identified an out-of-area contact person** to call to report you are safe?
- Why is this important?
 - Communications maybe down in an evacuation area. The out-of-area contact person can notify family and friends you are safe.
- Packed cotton or wool clothes in your go bag - remember synthetics burn and melt onto one's skin
